This resource is designed to help students think about how their career in music might fit with their lifestyle preferences. It prompts students to consider how much money they would like to make, their preferred hours of work, and the extent to which they need consistency.

Time allowance

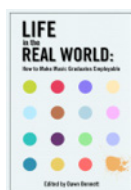
Allow students 10 minutes to complete the resource and then move to the analysis. If you can, do the quiz alongside them and share your responses.
